This month we are devoting teaching in our services to the topic of Stewardship. Jesus has entrusted to us, his disciples, a commission to share his love though our giving, not just our money but also our gifts, talents, and time. Discipleship and stewardship are indivisible, for both are about sharing His love.

So, this month we hope to gain a better understanding of the biblical basis of stewardship. Our clergy will be traveling around each parish, each exploring one unique aspect of stewardship. The morning will be facilitated by Gwilym Stone from the Inclusive Church Network, Rev Jo Mulliner, Rector of Basing and Lychpit, and our own clergy team. The session will be followed by a light lunch for those that would like to stay (or head over to the pub lunch at the Pelican Pamber Heath).

Sunday 29th 10.15am - Benefice Service at St. Paul's. We round off our Stewardship month with a special benefice service led by our clergy team and Revd Georgi Thompson Leask, Winchester Diocese Stewardship Advisor. The service will be followed by a bring-and-share lunch in St. Paul's hall, again demonstrating what happens when we all give a little - 1 quiche won't feed 3 parishes, but when we all bring something along we are all get fed (please don't all bring quiches!)
